AdrenalineUSMLE Identity, Terms of Use, Privacy, Refund, and Platform Policies

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AdrenalineUSMLE is a readiness-focused educational technology platform designed to support question-based learning, weakness identification, targeted educational repair, performance analytics, and continuous educational progression for medical learners preparing for the USMLE and related examinations.

This document constitutes the official Identity, Terms of Use, Privacy Policies, Refund Policies, Subscription Policies, Educational Disclaimers, Intellectual Property Policies, Platform Rules, Security Policies, and related legal notices of AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

By creating an account, accessing Diagnostic access, subscribing to Sprint or Alpha, purchasing SFYN6 Boost message credits, using referral links, accessing educational content, or otherwise using the AdrenalineUSMLE platform, users acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to these policies, including future policy updates to the extent permitted by applicable law.

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1. Platform Identity

AdrenalineUSMLE is an online medical education platform focused on USMLE Step 1-style readiness, NBME-style reasoning, question-based learning, weakness identification, targeted educational videos, and measurable performance improvement.

Official platform access is provided through AdrenalineUSMLE.com. The platform operates online only at this stage and does not maintain a public physical office.

This document outlines the terms, privacy practices, subscription rules, refund policy, and platform policies for AdrenalineUSMLE. It is for informational purposes only and not legal advice. AdrenalineUSMLE may update these policies as needed based on evolving services and legal requirements.

2. What AdrenalineUSMLE Provides

AdrenalineUSMLE may provide digital educational tools designed to help students measure readiness, identify weak areas, and improve through question-based learning, targeted explanations, and performance feedback.

AdrenalineUSMLE is a growing platform. Its content, tools, dashboards, playlists, educational systems, QBank materials, QTV™ explanations, and performance features may expand, change, or improve over time.

AdrenalineUSMLE may provide, depending on the user's access level:

- USMLE-focused QBank and NBME-style reasoning practice
- Diagnostic access, Sprint access, Alpha access, SFYN6 Boost, and admin-managed educational content
- QTV™ educational explanations and targeted video-based learning pathways
- performance dashboards, readiness analytics, weakness detection, and system/topic performance tracking
- recommended playlists, recommended videos, and review tools for incorrect, marked, solved, and unanswered questions
- lab values, timer preferences, session progress, streak data, learning history, and performance records
- support forms, report submissions, issue review, platform communications, and account-related notifications

Access to specific features may depend on account status, verification status, subscription status, plan type, platform availability, and applicable access permissions.



3. Company Information and Legal Entity

AdrenalineUSMLE is owned and operated by AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC, a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, United States.

AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC develops, owns, manages, licenses, and controls the AdrenalineUSMLE platform, including its website, software systems, question bank, QTV library, weakness taxonomy, readiness engine, performance analytics, learning paths, educational videos, scripts, diagrams, dashboards, source code, databases, visual assets, branding materials, and related intellectual property.

Throughout these Terms, references to "**AdrenalineUSMLE**," "**we**," "**our**," or "**us**" refer to AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

AdrenalineUSMLE is an independent educational technology platform designed to support readiness assessment, weakness identification, targeted educational repair, and performance-guided preparation for medical examinations.

Ownership, operation, maintenance, support, billing, subscriptions, intellectual property management, and platform development are conducted by AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

4. Official Language

The official language of AdrenalineUSMLE is English.

Platform text, policies, account messages, subscription information, payment notices, support communications, educational content, video explanations, voice explanations, diagrams, tables, dashboards, QBank materials, QTV™ content, and related platform materials are intended to be provided in English unless AdrenalineUSMLE clearly states otherwise.

AdrenalineUSMLE does not currently provide official support, translation, interpretation, or guaranteed educational content in other languages.

If any non-English wording, translation, subtitle, legacy material, or informal explanation appears on the platform, the English version controls to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

5. Account Registration and Acceptance of Terms

A user must review and accept the applicable AdrenalineUSMLE policies before account creation, OTP delivery, account activation, subscription access, or access to protected platform features.

By creating an account or using the platform, the user confirms that they are responsible for reading, understanding, and complying with the applicable AdrenalineUSMLE Identity, Terms of Use, Privacy Policy, Refund Policy, Data Use Policy, and Subscription Terms.

AdrenalineUSMLE may store policy acceptance records, including the acceptance date, policy version, user ID, account email, acceptance status, and IP/session information where logged.

If policy acceptance is not confirmed, registration must be blocked. The platform should not create the account, send an OTP, activate the account, process protected access, or grant access to premium features.

6. Account Verification and Access Levels

AdrenalineUSMLE uses access-level controls to determine which platform features, content, tools, and account areas a user may access.

Verified email, valid account status, active subscription status, payment status, and platform permissions may be required before a user can access protected or premium features.

Subscription status controls access to premium content, but account data, learning history, question attempts, performance records, and dashboard activity are separate from subscription status. Access levels may include:

- **Admin Access:** restricted internal access for platform management, content management, support, reporting, and administrative functions.

AdrenalineUSMLE may modify, restrict, suspend, or remove access levels where required for payment status, security, account verification, policy enforcement, platform integrity, or technical reasons.

7. Subscription Plans, Pricing, Billing, and Access

AdrenalineUSMLE offers educational access plans, subscriptions, trials, limited-access programs, promotional offerings, and other digital services, which may be modified, expanded, discontinued, or replaced from time to time at the sole discretion of AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

Diagnostic access is free, does not require a credit card, is not a purchase, and does not automatically renew or convert into Sprint.

Features, content availability, release schedules, and educational offerings may vary by plan and may be modified, expanded, or discontinued by AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

8. Diagnostic Access, Sprint, Alpha and SFYN6 Boost

AdrenalineUSMLE Diagnostic access provides limited introductory educational access to selected platform features for a period of three (3) days at no cost.

Diagnostic access is free, does not require a credit card, is not a purchase, and does not renew automatically. Diagnostic access does not automatically convert into Sprint, Alpha, or any paid subscription.

Sprint is a paid monthly subscription currently priced at USD \$99/month unless modified or replaced by AdrenalineUSMLE.

Alpha is a paid three-month subscription currently priced at USD \$199/3 months unless modified or replaced by AdrenalineUSMLE.

SFYN6 Boost is an optional message-credit purchase currently priced at USD \$5 for 100 additional SFYN6 messages. SFYN6 Boost does not replace Sprint or Alpha access and does not unlock premium educational content unless the user otherwise has an eligible plan.



9. Payment Email Matching Rule

The email address used during checkout should match the email address associated with the user's AdrenalineUSMLE account. Platform access is generally activated based upon the email address associated with the completed payment.

If the payment email does not correspond to an existing, verified, or active AdrenalineUSMLE account, access activation may be delayed, placed under pending review, or require manual verification.

Users who complete payment using a different, alternate, or incorrect email address are responsible for contacting support@adrenalineusmle.com to request assistance and account verification.

AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC is not responsible for delays in account activation, access issues, or verification delays resulting from the use of an incorrect, alternate, unverified, or mismatched checkout email address.

10. Payments, Billing, Cancellation, and Renewal

Payments for AdrenalineUSMLE subscriptions, plans, trials, promotional access, and related services may be processed through Stripe or other payment processors approved by AdrenalineUSMLE, LLC.

Paid Sprint and Alpha subscriptions may renew automatically according to the billing terms, renewal schedule, and subscription details presented to the user at checkout unless canceled before the applicable renewal date. Free Diagnostic access does not renew automatically.
